

Full Ceremony - SCATTERING of CREMAINS at Moth Memorials

(Without participation of an ordained minister)

CONFIDENTIAL TO THE MOTH: NOT FOR PUBLICATION

- ***Cremains to be placed before the Memorial and prior to service commencment.
 - Relatives and visitors will be seated If seating available. (relatives to be located closest to the head of the service).
 - Moths gather at appropriate point, determined by the Sgt-Major or Ceremony elected Moth Representative: "Moths, Stand Easy"

Deputy Old Bill or Ceremony elected Moth member:

Be it known to all present that Moth (<u>Name and Surname</u>), of (<u>Name of Shellhole</u>), has answered the sunset call, and has gone to meet higher command.

Old Bill or Ceremony elected Moth member:

"And (Moth's Name) said to the man who stood at the Gate of the Year, "Give me a light, that I may tread safely into the Unknown", and he replied:

"Go out into the darkness and place your hand in the hand of God. That, for you, is safer than a light, and better than the known way". Old Bill or elected Moth member calls on the family (and friends) to join him with the Scattering of Cremains, starting with the closest relative (wive, oldest child, etc.)

The Old Bill or elected Moth member will stand aside to allow the rest of the gathering to scatter the Cremains.

***In progress of or when complete, and while the family are still gathered at the Front, the Old Bill or elected Moth member recites:-

"We commit the Cremains of our dear brother <u>(Moths Full name)</u> to the Elements; earth to earth, ashes to ashes, dust to dust; and we commend <u>(Moths First name)</u> to the just and merciful judgement of He who has perfect understanding......Amen"

Old Bill or Ceremony elected Moth member: "ALL"

Let us say the Lords' Prayer together:-

"Our Father, who art in Heaven
Hallowed be thy name.
Thy kingdom come,
Thy will be done,
On Earth, as it is in Heaven.
Give us this day our daily bread,
And forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.
