AWARD OF THE 40th CERTIFICATE OF COMRADESHIP

Moth Leon Maree was inducted on the 10th of May 2019 at Marshal Smuts Shellhole. At an equivalent pace to that of the speed of sound, he was thrust into MOTH affairs and immediately showed himself to be up to the challenge.

At the Shellhole's 74th Annual General Meeting during July 2019 he was installed as Paybill and merely a month later he was appointed to the position of Assistant Provincial Paybill. At Marshal Smuts Moth Maree had an immediate impact with his professional attitude to the task at hand and this enhanced the Shellhole's reputation even further as being in a league of its own when it comes to administration and management!

At Provincial level Moth Maree started a process of building capacity for Paybills at smaller Shellholes which quickly enshrined him as the go-to-man. His contributions to the financial management of our own Shellhole as well as other Units within the Province during the lockdown period of Covid-19 proved to be extremely valuable. When his predecessor as Provincial Paybill retired, Moth Maree was a unanimous choice to replace him.

Through this new Office, Moth Maree instituted Smartedge Workshops to train all Paybills within the Province. In a mere eight months this system has allowed all Units to be up-to-date with Smartedge reporting and ensured that he was appointed by the National Treasurer as a Special Assistant on the MOTH Smartedge Accounting System.

As proposed by Moth George van Zyl, it gives the Executive Committee great pleasure to award the **Certificate of Comradeship to 23832 Moth Leon Michael Maree**, a worthy recipient who has proven over an extended period of time that he is knowledgeable of the **Way to Higher Comradeship**.
